The Hudson Passive Project Open House


...part of International Passive House Days, a global passive house event

BY CAR: From NYC:

Saw Mill Parkway to Exit 26 for the Taconic State Parkway North Take NY-82 Exit toward Ancram/Hudson (heading West) At the West Taconic Fire Station (first Right), take Old Rt. 82 Turn right at Water Street Road Continue onto Millbrook Road Stay left at fork to Continue on Millbrook Look for Dennis Wedlick Architect LLC sign at end of drive.

From Hudson, NY:

From Warren Street, take 1st right onto US-9 S/Worth Ave Continue to follow US-9 S Turn left at NY-23 E/US-9 S Continue onto NY-82 S Turn left at Bells Pond Rd/Co Rd 12 Stay left at intersection of Belles Pond Road, Millbrook and Water Street Road Stay left at fork to Continue on Millbrook Look for Dennis Wedlick Architect LLC sign at end of drive.

BY TRAIN: Amtrak to Hudson, NY then cab/drive (approx 20 minutes from train station)
